Donated items should be in clean, gently used re-sellable condition. We accept clothing, books, furniture, house-wares, home decor, lamps, books, pocketbooks, shoes, sports and cleats, crafts, jewelry, some electronics and computer equipment (not old type monitors) and VHS/CD's.

We cannot accept-TV's, TV cabinets, mattresses, box springs, bed pillows, golf clubs, old cribs, recalled baby items, exercise equipment, skis/boots and particle board. Due to the nature of goods sold we cannot accept returns.

Late night Tuesday is also our Senior Citizens Day too. 50% off clothing and footwear. You must be 59 and a half to be eligible for our very special discount!
